Today's Pledge

On November 7th the United States Navy commissions the USS New York, an amphibious transport ship containing almost 200,000 pounds of steel in its bow stem that was salvaged from the ruins of the World Trade Center following the terrorist attacks of September 11, 2001. Constructed in New Orleans, it was christened "New York" to honor the 9/11 attack victims in that city. The original USS New York was decommissioned at the end of WWII.

The warship's motto is "**NEVER FORGET**," for the victims of the September 11, 2001, attacks, which claimed almost 3000 lives. Capt. Bill Galinis, the program manager for the Navy's Program Executive Office for ships, described the USS New York as "a **SYMBOL**."
