SUBJECT: NOTICE OF ASBESTOS ABATEMENT
MINOOKA COMMUNITY HIGH SCHOOL - CENTRAL CAMPUS

In accordance with the requirements of the Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) *Asbestos Abatement Act for Public and Private Schools* (77 Ill. Adm. Code 855 Section 855.450), Minooka HSD 111 is hereby notifying parents, faculty and staff of asbestos abatement activities to be performed in relation to planned renovation activities within our school.

In order to provide for a safe and healthy environment for our students, faculty and staff, the District has retained the services of an Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) Licensed Asbestos Abatement Contractor (Holian Asbestos Removal & Encapsulation) to conduct planned abatement activities. In addition, the District has retained the services of an independent environmental engineering firm (True North Consultants) to develop technical specifications for the performance of asbestos abatement activities and to provide on-site consultation and management of asbestos abatement activities for the duration of the project. All abatement activities will be performed utilizing strict engineering controls and work practices in accordance with applicable federal, state and local regulations.

Asbestos abatement activities are currently scheduled to commence on May 12, 2020 with an anticipated completion date no later than June 5, 2020. The scope of abatement activities will consist of the non-friable removal of asbestos-containing floor tile and floor tile adhesive as part of planned renovation activities within our school. Access to specified abatement areas will be restricted during abatement activities. Therefore, access to portions of the building may be limited during the aforementioned dates.
