MCHS will offer the PSAT/NMSQT on October 10th. 10th and 11th grade students can take the PSAT/NMSQT in October, in order to practice for the SAT and qualify for potential entry into the National Merit Scholarship Program. If you are a 10th or 11th grade student who would like to take the PSAT/NMSQT on October 10th, please complete the following:

- 1. **BEGINNING SEPTEMBER 4TH,** students can register to pay for the test online. The cost of the test is \$16. Registration will **END SEPTEMBER 28TH!**
- 2. Go to the MCHS website (www.mchs.net) and click on "Students & Parents." Select "Web Store" and click "Student Fees." Select your appropriate grade and click on the link to register/pay for PSAT/NMSQT.
- 3. Check the Academic Resource Center (A.R.C.) for testing room assignments.
- 4. Report to your usual campus **ON OCTOBER 10th** and go to your assigned testing room. Testing will begin at 8am.

About the test:

- 2 hours and 45 minutes in length
- Components include the Reading test, the Writing and Language test, and the Math test
- No penalties for guessing
- Focus on the skills identified as necessary for college readiness
- Practice tests available in the MCHS Career Center
- Automatic screening for the National Merit Scholarship Program
