Participation in Extracurricular Activities (No Pass - No Play)

The Board of Education of District #111 encourages its students to broaden their skills, knowledge and citizenship by participating in school-sponsored clubs, councils, interscholastic and intramural athletics, theatrical productions, and other extracurricular activities. However, participation in school-sponsored and school-supported athletic and extracurricular activities will be subject to the following:

High School Participation

In order to be eligible for participation in any school-sponsored or school-supported athletic or extracurricular activity, each student in grade 9, 10, 11, or 12 must maintain an overall grade point average of at least 1.5 at the end of each quarter.

Any student who fails to meet the aforesaid requirement will be suspended from further participation in all school-sponsored and school-supported athletic and extracurricular activities until the student attains an overall grade point average of at least 1.5 in a subsequent quarter.

Participation in school-sponsored or school-supported athletic or extracurricular activities may also be subject to additional eligibility requirements imposed by the Illinois High School Association or other governing bodies.

For purposes of this policy, "extracurricular activity" is defined as any ongoing, regularly scheduled activity of a club or organization for which a staff sponsor or supervisor is assigned, and does not include one-time events.

Reporting

A copy of this policy shall be filed with the Illinois State Board of Education concurrently upon its adoption. After this policy has been in effect for one year, the Superintendent is directed to file a report with the Illinois State Board of Education setting forth the number and length of suspensions imposed under this policy during the period covered by the report.
