Mary Pat Collins was a lifetime educator in the Minooka area for over 33 years. She began her teaching career in the Grundy County Rural Schools, teaching first at the Cryder School and then the Dresden Hill School. She concluded her teaching career at the Channahon School District where she taught first and second grade until 1986. Her teaching career did not terminate with her retirement. She continued to be an active substitute teacher and found other avenues in which to help out in the local community.

Her passion for teaching was instilled upon her daughter and two of her granddaughters. Her daughter and her husband (Beth and Terry McDonald) spent their teaching career in the Channahon School system.
